## Art Supplies

### Paints

Water based Paint  
– Red, Yellow, Blue, Black, White

Paint Brushes  
(anything you have – even paint decorating brushes / sponges)

Container for water

Container for holding small amounts of each colour



## Art Supplies

Container for mixing colours (containers can be anything – even a plate – water based paints e.g. tempura / poster, are safe enough to wash off your household surfaces)

Paper/cloth scraps for wiping brush

### **Other Media**

Oil Pastels – mixed colours. They may be a little more expensive than crayons but they are incredibly versatile.

Coloured Pencils and Lead Pencils (e.g. HB)

Pencils / sharpener / erasers

A4 cartridge paper (e.g. printer paper) – White.

A3 also very useful

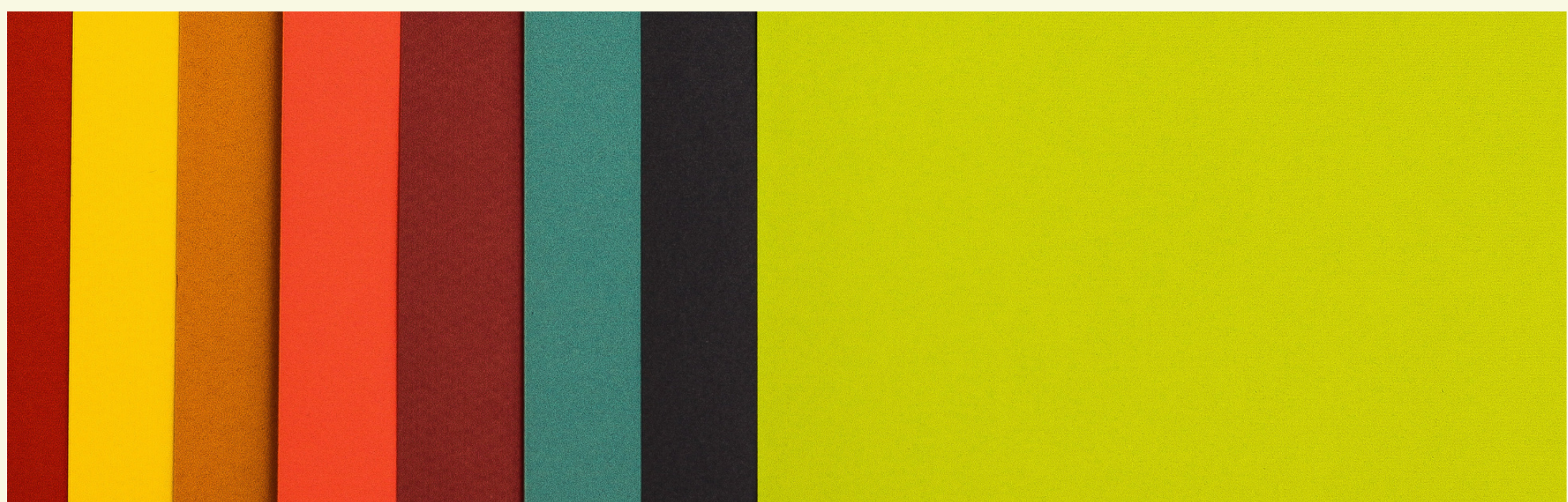
A4 Card – White and coloured (or paint your white any colour you want).
